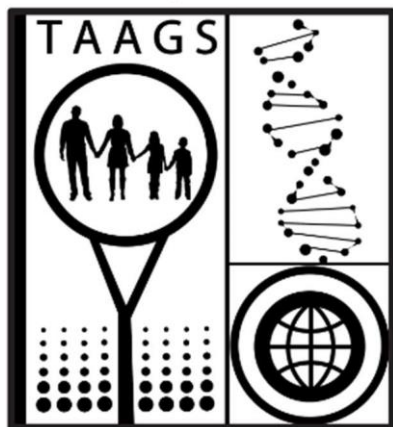
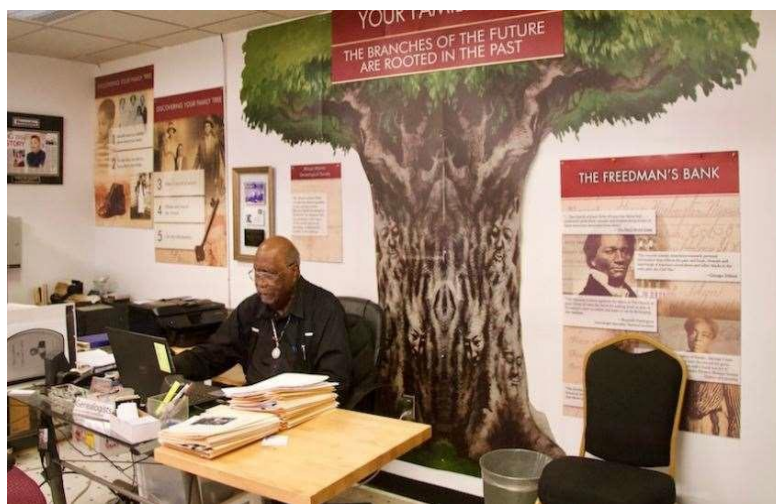


The African Atlantic Genealogical Society
